

# 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE BOOK REPORT OPTIONS

## REQUIREMENTS:

- \*A book report is due at the end of each quarter. Deadline will be set at least one month prior to due date.
- \*Students must turn in the title of the book they are doing their report on the due date assigned. A note will come home approximately one month before the due that that will require student and parent signature.
- \*Students should read the book they choose as part of their 20 minutes (or more) of nightly reading. Once the book is done, students should continue to read another book nightly. Just because the book report is done, doesn't mean reading is done!
- \*All reports will be presented in front of the class for an oral presentation grade
- \*Reports will also be graded for accuracy, effort, and organization.
- \*Book reports will be part of your reading grade.
- \*Each book report is considered a quarterly homework project. All projects must be completed by student. Occasionally class time will be given, but most of the project will be required to be done at home. If materials are needed, please ask ahead of time.

<p><b>BOOK COMMERCIAL</b></p> <p>Be the star of your very own commercial! Students may use template provided, or write their own. Must be recorded ahead of time. File must be saved electronically.</p>	<p><b>AMAZON LISTING</b></p> <p>Your new job is a marketing expert! Every book on Amazon has a listing that informs buyers about the book. Your job is to create a paper version for the novel you have read. Format provided.</p>	<p><b>PUMPKIN CHARACTER</b></p> <p>Transform a foam pumpkin to look like your character and write up a summary of their character traits based on the things they say/do in the book.</p>
<p><b>CEREAL BOX</b></p> <p>Design a cereal box for your book. Must include: cover of book, a clever name for your "cereal", characters/setting/theme, summary of the book, design a game, title/author/page numbers, and special prize related to something that is significant to the book.</p>	<p><b>SING A SONG</b></p> <p>Fine tune your songwriting skills! Create a song or rap describing your book. You may record it or perform it in front of the class. Your lyrics must include: characters, setting, and summary of reading.</p>	<p><b>MATCHBOOK</b></p> <p>For each chapter of your book, create a mini matchbook. On the outside of the matchbook, draw &amp; color your favorite scene from that chapter. On the inside, write a 5 to 7 sentence summary of the chapter. All matchbooks should be glued in a bigger file folder.</p>
<p><b>SHOEBOX DIORAMA</b></p> <p>Recreate a scene from the book inside of a box to create a 3 dimensional display. Include title, author, and main characters.</p>	<p><b>WRITE UP/GOOGLE SLIDES</b></p> <p>Use the provided template to create a write up of the book. Each section of the write up will be a slide in your Google Slides presentation.</p>	<p><b>T-SHIRT</b></p> <p>Design a tshirt for your book! Summarize your book with main parts represented on your shirt. Present the shirt to class with a summary of the book, without spoiling the ending!</p>
